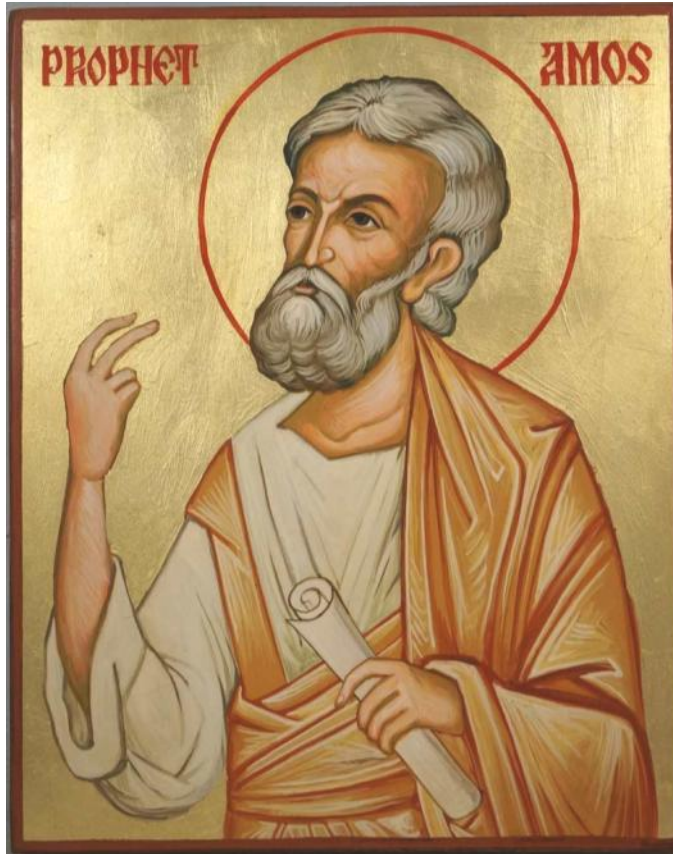

**Parish Picnic:** Today immediately following the 10:30AM service the Annual Parish Picnic will be held at The Rectory, 8 Loudon Heights South, Loudonville, NY 12211. **Youth Sunday:** Youth Sunday returns next Sunday, September 29th and will continue to be held on the last Sunday of each month. On the last Sunday of each month we invite the children of our parish to take special part at the 10:30AM service. The teens will fill important roles during the service in the Sanctuary. Additionally, we will be offering **Children's Chapel** for our youngest members.
