Coffee Hour: As stated in Bishop Love's guidelines, no coffee hour will be offered.

In-Church Sunday Service: Beginning today, June 21st St. Peter's Church can increase the number of attendees for the 10:30AM Holy Communion Sunday Service from 10 people to 50+ people. There are 28 pews that will be used for seating. Please refer to Fr. Hartt's letter that was mailed out on June 15th for the guidelines. This letter was also emailed to you through Constant Contact. If you did not receive an email please call the church office to have your email address added to our Constant Contact list. Thank you.

Wednesday Noon Service: Holy Communion is offered in the backyard of the Rectory on Wednesdays at Noon. This service is limited to 9 worshipers. Masks must be worn and strict social distancing of at least 6 feet will be required at all times. Please call the church to make your Wednesday Service reservation.

Church Office/Staff: We are happy to announce that the church office has re-opened and the staff have eagerly returned to work. We are now working on summer hours which are 9AM to 4PM, Monday through Friday, from June 15th through Labor Day, September 7th.

CROP Walk: The Albany CROP Walk, which took place on Sunday, May 3rd, had a total of 230 walkers and raised a total of \$90,000.00 (\$22,000.00 of which supports local food pantries in the Capital District.) Thank you again for supporting this year's CROP Walk!
