Coffee Hour: Please join us for coffee hour after the 10:30AM service. All are welcome.

Class on Episcopal Confession – “All May. None Must. Some Should.” The phrase “Go to Confession” can conjure up images of Roman Catholic priests assigning “Hail Marys” as penance. Yet there is a form of this sacramental practice that is part of our Episcopal heritage. We’ll gather today after the 10:30AM service to learn about that practice. We’ll also spend a few minutes learning about a private prayer practice known as the “Examen” that is a great aid in self-reflection. This class is part of the St. Peter’s Prayer School series.

Vestry Meeting: Due to the Shrove Pancake Supper falling on the second Tuesday of the month, the February Vestry meeting has been moved to tomorrow, Monday, February 12th at 5:15pm in the second floor meeting room.

BURNING OF THE PALMS: The congregation is invited to bring last year’s blessed palms from Palm Sunday to church to be burned and turned into the blessed ashes that are distributed on Ash Wednesday. The palms will be burned at a short prayer service during the Shrove Tuesday gathering this year (children welcome!). A labeled basket will be placed in the Tower Chapel to collect palms until today, the Last Sunday after the Epiphany, February 11th.

SHROVE TUESDAY: Our annual Shrove Tuesday Pancake Supper will be held this Tuesday, February 13th from 5PM to 6:30PM. Volunteers are needed to cook and should arrive by 4PM. Many other volunteers are needed for clean-up so that the Parish Hall can be ready by 7PM for the arrival of the men from the Overflow Shelter. If you have any questions or are volunteering to cook, please contact Janice Chenot at (518)786-1070.

Ash Wednesday Services: Please join us for services this Wednesday, February 14th. They are as follows: 12PM and 5:30PM both with imposition of ashes. The 12PM service will be a noontime service and the 5:30PM service will be a full Holy Communion service with choir.

Lent Early Morning Prayer on Zoom: Beginning this Wednesday (Ash Wednesday), February 14th at 6:30AM, Mtr. Christina will lead Morning Prayer on Zoom, Wednesdays through Fridays, ending on Good Friday, March 29th. The service takes about 20 minutes. Coffee and pajamas are just fine. Sunday Study of the Lenten Saints: John and Charles Wesley. Anna Julia Haywood Cooper. Janani Luwum. Patrick of Ireland. CHORAL EVENSONG DURING LENT: St. Peter's will offer Choral Evensong at 5:30PM on three Fridays during the season of Lent: February 23rd, March 8th and March 22nd. Choral Evensong is the traditional sung version of Anglican Evening Prayer, sung in the English Cathedral tradition. The parish choir prepares a significant amount of choral music for these services, which provides for an especially beautiful and artistic form of worship. Following Evensong, everyone is invited to food and fellowship at a local restaurant that serves fish.
