Lenten Saints Study: Every Sunday during Lent following the 10:30AM service, we'll be learning about saints who are part of our Anglican/Episcopal heritage and whose "saint day" falls in Lent. Each study will include a brief bio of the saint and a group discussion. This week's saints are John and Charles Wesley, brothers and Anglican priests who led a revival in the Church of England in the 1700s and whose influence is still felt in the Methodist movement and through thousands of hymns that Charles wrote. Today's study will be led by Mtr. Christina.
