Coffee Hour: Please join us for coffee hour after the 10:30AM service. All are welcome.

Guest Preacher: Today Dr. John Davis will be preaching. John is licensed as a Lay Preacher by the Albany Diocese. We are grateful to John and we thank him for his service today and for his continued dedication to St. Peter's Church and our congregation.

Children's Chapel: Children's Chapel will be held today during the 10:30AM service. Please join Mother Christina in the Sunday School Chapel on the second floor of the Guild House. We hope you will bring your children to participate in this children's ministry.

Lenten Saints Study: Every Sunday during Lent following the 10:30AM service, we'll be learning about saints who are part of our Anglican/Episcopal heritage and whose "saint day" falls in Lent. Each study will include a brief bio of the saint and a group discussion. This week's saint is George Herbert, an Anglican priest and scholar who is famous for his poems. Two of his poems are also well-known hymns: "Teach me, my God and King" and "Let all the world in every corner sing". Today's class will be led by Dr. John Davis.

Learn to Pray - St. Peter's Prayer School: This adult education course will meet this Wednesday, March 13th at 12:30PM in the Pumpelly Room. A second session of the class will meet on Palm Sunday, March 24th following the 10:30AM service. This month's class is: "Lectio Divina – Praying God's Word."

Lent Early Morning Prayer on Zoom: Beginning Ash Wednesday and continuing through Good Friday, Mtr. Christina will lead Morning Prayer on Zoom at 6:30AM every Wednesday, Thursday and Friday morning during Lent. The service takes about 20 minutes. Coffee and pajamas are just fine. THE LAST SUPPER: On Sunday, March 17th during the 10:30AM service the Sunday School will reenact the Last Supper. This will include the story of Jesus and his disciples, washing of our feet and taking part in the Most Holy Bread and Wine (juice). All are welcome to take part in this wonderful activity.

CHORAL EVENSONG DURING LENT: St. Peter's will offer a final Choral Evensong at 5:45PM on March 22nd. Choral Evensong is the traditional sung version of Anglican Evening Prayer, sung in the English Cathedral tradition. The parish choir prepares a significant amount of choral music for these services, which provides for an especially beautiful and artistic form of worship. Following Evensong, everyone is invited to food and fellowship at a local restaurant that serves fish.

EASTER EGG COLORING: On Sunday, March 24th the Sunday School children will be coloring Easter eggs during the 10:30AM service. Please allow them to dress in "old clothes" - but just in case, there will be a small number of smocks available. We hope all of the children will join in this fun event!

MAUNDY THURSDAY: On Maundy Thursday, March 28th at 7:30PM, please join us for a service of Holy Communion. During this moving service the altars will be stripped and covered in black.

GOOD FRIDAY MUSIC: On Good Friday, March 29th at 1:15 PM following the Noon service, the St. Peter's Choir accompanied by orchestra will present **THE CRUCIFIXION** by John Stainer, a Meditation on the Sacred Passion of the Holy Redeemer. All are welcome to attend as your schedule allows, free of charge.
