Coffee Hour: Please join us for coffee hour after the 8:30AM and 10:30AM Services. All are welcome.

Newcomers: If you are interested in receiving more information about St. Peter's Church please feel free to call the church office or fill out an information card that is located in your pew. If you would like to be added to the church directory please call the church office.

Youth Sunday: Today is Youth Sunday. On the last Sunday of each month we invite the children of our parish to take special part at the 10:30AM service. The teens will fill important roles during the service in the Sanctuary. Additionally, we will be offering **Children's Chapel** for our youngest members. In lieu of our traditional Sunday School offering, pre-Confirmation youth and Sunday School teachers will celebrate a Youth Eucharist in the Pumpelly Room during the service. Children will begin worship with the parents in the main Sanctuary and following the first reading the children will be invited to process into Children's Chapel for their own Gospel message, homily and instructed Eucharist service. Please speak to Fr. Hartt or Mtr. Sue if your child would like to have a special role during an upcoming Youth Sunday.

First Holy Communion Classes: The final instruction class for First Holy Communion will be today following the 10:30AM service. These individuals will celebrate First Holy Communion next Sunday on All Saints' Sunday, November 4th during the 10:30AM service.

ALPHA SERIES: Due to Halloween, the Alpha Series Course will not meet this Wednesday, October 31st.

Daylight Saving Time: The end of daylight saving time will occur next Sunday, November 4th. Don't forget to set your clocks back one hour before you go to bed on Saturday evening.

Christian Education/Formation: Confirmation Class: Confirmation instruction for adults and youth (aged 13+) will begin on Sunday, November 11th. The classes will be co-led by Fr. Hartt and Mtr. Sue and will meet over the course of the next few months following the 10:30AM service in the Vestry Room (with springtime Confirmation being planned). Please note that regular church worship attendance, along with Confirmation classes, are an ongoing expectation for those seeking Confirmation. Please speak with Fr. Hartt or Mother Sue if you (or your youth) are interested in joining us.

Sunday School: On Sunday, November 11th, the Sunday School children will be baking pumpkin bread so please have them dress accordingly. The bread will be blessed the following Sunday, November 18th after which the loaves will be available to the congregation to take home.
