Healing Prayers: Today is the first Sunday of the month and prayers for healing will be offered *during* Holy Communion in the Tower Altar at the rear of the church. If you desire prayers and/or anointing, please join us in the Tower Altar after you have received Holy Communion.

Daughters of the King: The October DOK meeting will be held next Sunday, October 8th immediately following the 10:30AM service in the vestry room. All Daughters, and women of the parish interested in learning about the Daughters, are invited to attend. We will be updating our prayer list and planning the Fall Prayer Walk.

Blessing of the Animals: Mtr. Sue is pleased to offer a Service for Blessing of the Animals in our St. Francis Garden next Sunday, October 8th at 3PM. We welcome you and family members to bring your pet(s) on a leash or in a carrier.

Outreach Committee and Vestry Meetings: These October meetings will be held on **Wednesday**, October 11th. Outreach Committee will meet at 4:30PM and Vestry will meet at 5:15PM.

Neighborhood Prayer Walk: On Sunday, October 15th, please join us after services to walk our "neighborhood" soaking it in prayer. All members of St. Peter's are invited to join the Daughters. We depart from St. Peter's and make numerous stops, offering prayers at Academy Park, Veterans Memorials, the NYS Capitol, the Capital City Rescue Mission and the bus station. The full walk lasts approximately one hour but parishioners may choose the shorter walk as well (approximately 20 minutes).

Women's Bible Study: Join the women of the church as we read and discuss Joanna Weaver's *Lazarus Awakening:* Finding Your Place in the Heart of God. We meet on Tuesdays at 5PM in the Vestry room (except when Vestry meets on the 2nd Tuesday of the month). We read one chapter weekly and discuss it together to reflect on its Biblical connection and life application. The cost of the book is \$8.00 (with scholarship funds available - please ask). Please let Mother Sue know you will be reading along with us and a book will be ordered for you.

Adult History Study: Turning Points: Decisive Moments in the History of Christianity by Mark Noll. This book focuses on the decisive moments in Christian history. Turning Points has 13 chapters as well as an important introduction and includes study questions at the close of each chapter. We are working through the book in a corresponding number of sessions. Given the worthwhile Introduction and 13 "turning points," it makes sense to split our discussion classes into seven for the fall and seven for the start of next year. The classes take about ninety minutes to do justice to the material. We meet on Wednesday evenings at 5:45PM in the Vestry room.
