

**Coffee Hour:** Please join us for coffee hour after the 8:30AM and 10:30AM Services. All are welcome.

**Newcomers:** If you are interested in receiving more information about St. Peter's Church please feel free to call the church office or fill out an information card that is located in your pew. If you would like to be added to the church directory please call the church office.

**Neighborhood Prayer Walk:** Please join us today after services to walk our "neighborhood" soaking it in prayer. All members of St. Peter's are invited to join the Daughters. We depart from St. Peter's and make numerous stops, offering prayers at Academy Park, Veterans Memorials, the NYS Capitol, the Capital City Rescue Mission and the bus station. The full walk lasts approximately one hour but parishioners may choose the shorter walk as well (approximately 20 minutes).

**Pet Food Drive:** During the month of October, we will be collecting pet food and pet supplies to benefit the animals at the Mohawk Hudson Humane Society. The "Safe Haven Program" helps domestic violence victims place their pets in a safe and protected environment while securing their own safety. Simply place your donations in the box at the back of the church.

**Women's Bible Study:** Join the women of the church as we read and discuss Joanna Weaver's *Lazarus Awakening:* Finding Your Place in the Heart of God. We meet on Tuesdays at 5PM in the Vestry room (except when Vestry meets on the 2nd Tuesday of the month). We read one chapter weekly and discuss it together to reflect on its Biblical connection and life application. The cost of the book is \$8.00 (with scholarship funds available - please ask). Please let Mother Sue know you will be reading along with us and a book will be ordered for you.

Adult History Study: Turning Points: Decisive Moments in the History of Christianity by Mark Noll. This book focuses on the decisive moments in Christian history. Turning Points has 13 chapters as well as an important introduction and includes study questions at the close of each chapter. We are working through the book in a corresponding number of sessions. Given the worthwhile Introduction and 13 "turning points," it makes sense to split our discussion classes into seven for the fall and seven for the start of next year. The classes take about ninety minutes to do justice to the material. We meet on Wednesday evenings at 5:45PM in the Vestry room. Please refer to your September Newsletter for the full schedule and more information. It's not too late to join us.

**Blessing Bags:** To assist and offer comfort for the women who stay in our overflow shelter the Daughters of the King will be assembling Blessing Bags on Sunday, December 10th, 2017. These are small (quart size) bags of good will and hospitality that are given to people who may need some cheer and comfort. Please consider bringing an offering of women's care products such as tooth paste, tooth brush, a comb, scented lotion, hair rubber bands, mints, candies, wipes, granola bars, travel deodorant, lip balms, band aids, cotton swabs, small cracker packets, Slim Jim snacks, feminine pads/wipes, small tissue packets, small note pads and pens can also be useful. Products that contain alcohol such as mouth wash and hand sanitizer should not be included (hand sanitizer wipes are ok).
