Coffee Hour: Please join us for coffee hour after the 8:30AM service only. Due to the Celebration Luncheon today, coffee hour will not be held after the 10:30AM service.

Youth Sunday: Today is Youth Sunday. On the last Sunday of each month we invite the children of our parish to take special part at the 10:30AM service. The teens will fill important roles during the service in the Sanctuary. Additionally, we will be offering **Children's Chapel** for our youngest members. In lieu of our traditional Sunday School offering, pre-Confirmation youth and Sunday School teachers will celebrate a Youth Eucharist in the Pumpelly Room during the service. Children will begin worship with the parents in the main Sanctuary and following the first reading the children will be invited to process into Children's Chapel for their own Gospel message, homily and instructed Eucharist service. Please speak to Fr. Hartt or Mtr. Sue if your child would like to have a special role during an upcoming Youth Sunday.

Stewardship Campaign for 2018: Our Stewardship Campaign for 2018 has begun. A Stewardship letter from our Treasurer, George Scala, and a 2018 Pledge Card have been mailed out to all parishioners. Daylight Saving Time: The end of daylight saving time will occur next Sunday, November 5th. Don't forget to set your clocks back one hour before you go to bed on Saturday evening.

Christian Education/Formation: Confirmation Class: Confirmation instruction for adults and youth (aged 13+) will begin next Sunday on All Saints Sunday, November 5th. The class will be co-led by Fr. Hartt and Mtr. Sue and will meet during the months of November through January each Sunday (except 12/24 and 12/31) after the 10:30AM service.
