



Sunday School: Next Sunday, November 12th, the Sunday School children will be baking pumpkin bread so please have them dress accordingly. The bread will be blessed the following Sunday, November 19th after which the loaves will be available to the congregation to take home.

Christian Education/Formation: Confirmation Class: Confirmation instruction for adults and youth (aged 13+) will begin today, November 5th. The class will be co-led by Fr. Hartt and Mtr. Sue and will meet during the months of November through January each Sunday (except 12/24 and 12/31) after the 10:30AM service. We are preparing candidates to be Confirmed on Sunday February 11, 2018 at St. Peter's Church during Bishop Love's Visitation. Please speak with Fr. Thanksgiving Pies: Due to temperature variations in the church's ovens here at St. Peter's, the Choir will no longer be offering any **baked** pies.
