

Sunday School: Today the Sunday School children will be baking pumpkin bread and then next Sunday, November 19th the loaves will be blessed and will be available to the parish to take home.

Christian Education/Formation: Confirmation Class: Confirmation instruction for adults and youth (aged 13+) will begin today, November 12th. The class will be co-led by Fr. Hartt and Mtr. Sue and will meet during the months of November through January each Sunday (except 12/24 and 12/31) after the 10:30AM service.
