The pageant will be performed during the 10:30AM service next Sunday, December 10th. Please have the children arrive in costume at 10AM on the 10th.

**HANDEL'S MESSIAH:** Today at 3PM the St. Peter's Choir will present a performance of Handel's *Messiah*, accompanied by a chamber orchestra. There is no charge for admission and all are welcome to this performance.

**Christmas Project:** St. Peter's Parish is partnering with St. David's Parish, East Greenbush, to provide Christmas gifts to two recently relocated Burmese families for a total of 18 individuals.
