### Vestry Nominations:

The Vestry has nominated the following parish members to serve on the Vestry:

In the event of James Chenot's election to the position of Senior Warden, a vacancy will be created in the seat of Junior Warden. In the case of a vacancy, the vestry is empowered to fill it until the next Annual Meeting at which time the vestry-appointed seat will be opened for parish election. In the interest of transparency, the Vestry wishes to alert the parish that in the event James Chenot is elected as Sr. Warden, the Vestry has resolved to appoint Deborah Spath as Junior Warden until the next Annual Meeting.

Other nominations must be submitted to the church office in writing by this Wednesday, January 22nd in order to appear on the ballot.
