



This Oratorio-Passion sets the biblical text of St. Matthew's Passion narrative, interspersed with hymns of the day and arias which set poetic commentary by Christian Friedrich Henrici (known as Picaner). Together they present a powerful telling of the story of Christ's Passion. There is no charge for admission, and listeners are welcome to enter and leave as their schedules permit.
