Chrism Mass: The Chrism Mass originally scheduled for Monday, April 6th at 6PM has been cancelled.

GOOD FRIDAY MUSIC: Tentatively, our choir, accompanied by orchestra, will sing Bach's great *St. Matthew Passion* on Good Friday, April 10th at 1:15PM following the Noon liturgy. This Oratorio-Passion sets the biblical text of St. Matthew's Passion narrative, interspersed with hymns of the day and arias which set poetic commentary by Christian Friedrich Henrici (known as Picaner). Together they present a powerful telling of the story of Christ's Passion. There is no charge for admission, and listeners are welcome to enter and leave as their schedules permit.

Annual Easter Egg Hunt: Tentatively, all are welcome to join the Sunday School children on Saturday, April 11th for the annual St. Peter's Easter Egg Hunt. The festivities will begin at 11AM at the Rectory located at 8 Loudon Heights South, Loudonville, NY 12211. Please be sure to bring a basket and a friend!
