Instructions for Voting: Due to the pandemic, we will be allowing voting on the Vestry Elections by mail. In order to be sure to provide the right number of ballots for households, we ask that you request a ballot by phoning the Parish Office (518)434-3502. You will then be mailed your ballot(s) along with a pre-addressed envelope that will allow for anonymous voting. The envelope will be addressed to the church and have the return address of the church. You may also drop off your ballots at the Parish Office. All mailed ballots must be received by Monday, February 8th. Write-ins are permitted. Please make sure that any write-in candidate is placed next to the vestry seat that you would like your candidate to assume. Qualifications for voting will be on your ballot. We believe that this system will work best in this extraordinary year.
