

**Virtual Coffee Hour:** Our Zoom Coffee Hour continues each and every Sunday at 11:45AM. Grab a cup of coffee and join in! The Zoom app is necessary and readily available. **COVID Restrictions Lifted:** Following the directives of the New York State Health Department, the Standing Committee of the Episcopal Diocese of Albany has lifted all diocesan restrictions related to COVID-19, and encouraged parishes to begin gradually returning to normal worship routines. This is a wonderful and encouraging development, for which we give thanks to God. In the interests of safety and health, especially for the most vulnerable among us, our return to normal worship will be gradual. Beginning today, June 27th we will make the following changes to worship: Communion will be received at the rail (for the time being, the common cup will still not be distributed), some limited congregational singing with a gospel hymn, and child care will be offered at the 10:30AM service. We are so thankful to God to be able to move in this direction. Please continue to pray for an end to the pandemic, and for the health and safety of all.

They will be with us through Sunday, August 1st and they are staying at the Rectory during their time here. They will be taking turns preaching each Sunday and doing the Wednesday noon service.
