A Beautiful Mosaic

Our parish family is like the beautiful mosaic pattern that graces the floor of our sanctuary. The pattern is composed of many very small pieces of various colors. One piece is bright red, another deep blue, still another pale green, one is warm purple, another bright yellow, and yet another shining gold. No individual piece may seem particularly important, but without each and every one, the pattern would not be complete.

Many Christians, when asked, will express the feeling that there is little they can do for Christ or the church. They feel that their contribution to the life of the parish family is unimportant. However, all of us have been given unique gifts and abilities by our Creator. Some of them may seem more valuable or attract more attention, but no gift that God gives is useless. As St. Paul said,

Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; and there are varieties of services, but the same Lord; and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who activates all of them in everyone. To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. (1 Corinthians 12:4-7)

God's plan for all of us is to form a magnificent mosaic filled with the beauty of Christ's kindness, compassion, and forgiveness. During this Lenten season, let us humbly present our parish family mosaic as an offering to God, and let us pray that the Holy Spirit will use the pattern we have created to draw more people to Christ.
